
Expense Report Processes Now in Effect



<u>Steven Biegalski</u>, chair of Georgia Tech's Nuclear and Radiological Engineering and Medical Physics program, is receiving the 2025 George Hevesy Medal — the highest international award for career achievements in applied nuclear and radiochemistry. Biegalski is the first engineer to win the honor since it was established 57 years ago, and just the seventh American to receive it.



Ronald L. Johnson, chief of staff and senior vice president of Strategic Initiatives, will receive the Black Engineer of the Year Award at the Black Engineer of the Year Awards STEM Conference in February. The conference, hosted annually, is dedicated to honoring excellence in STEM and empowering diverse talent.



Gabriel A. Rincón-Mora, Motorola Solutions Foundation Professor in the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering, received the 2024 Outstanding Educator Award from the IEEE Atlanta Chapter. The award recognizes a member of the Atlanta community who has made an outstanding contribution to the electrotechnology profession.



James Wray, professor in the School of Earth and Atmospheric Sciences, was awarded a Simons Foundation Pivot Fellowship, one of the most prestigious sources of funding for cutting-edge research. The fellowships support leading researchers with the deep interest, curiosity, and drive to contribute to a new discipline.
