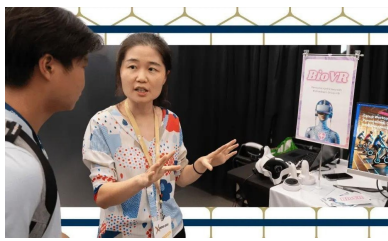
Showcase Your Talent at TechArts Festival
