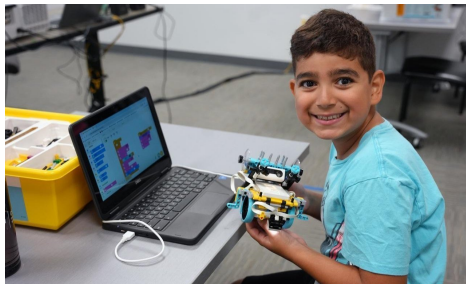

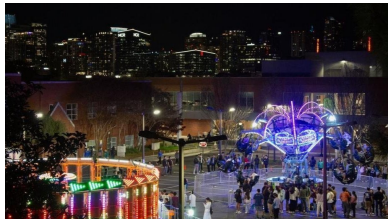

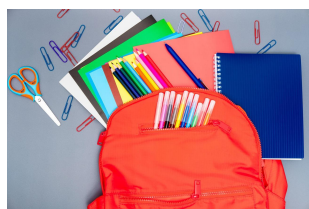
Support Expanding for Graduate Student Families
