Roberta Scheller, the beloved wife of Ernest "Ernie" Scheller Jr., died May 3. The Scheller community remembers the legacy she leaves behind.

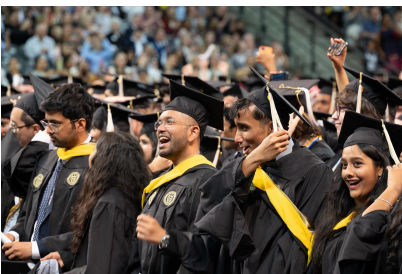

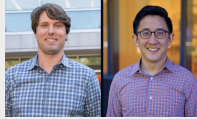
