Woodruff School of Mechanical Engineering, has been awarded the 2022 Max Jakob Memorial Award by the American Society of Mechanical Engineers and the American Institute of Chemical Engineers. As the highest honor given by the organizations, the award recognizes significant contributions to and achievements in the field of heat and mass transfer.
