Tech's Workplace Learning & Professional Development has expanded its offerings to include one-on-one coaching to help employees explore goals and identify growth opportunities.

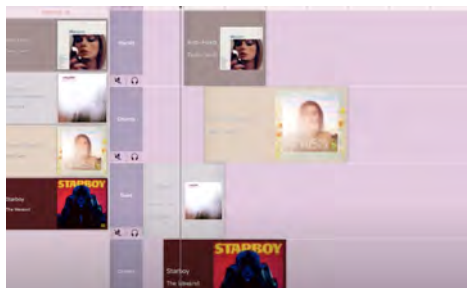
