<u>Victoria Chang</u>, Margaret T. and Henry C. Bourne Jr. Chair in Poetry, has been named the winner of The Forward Prize for best poetry collection. Chang won for her new volume, *With My Back to the World*, inspired by the work of artist Agnes Martin.
