## Faculty/Staff Achievements



Director of Athletics <u>J Batt</u> has been appointed chairman of the board of the College Football Hall of Fame. Batt, who has served on the Hall's board of trustees since August 2023, is the sixth chairman of the board since the College Football Hall of Fame moved to Atlanta in 2014.



<u>Suman Datta</u>, the Joseph M. Pettit Chair of Advanced Computing, Georgia Research Alliance Eminent Scholar, and professor in the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering professor, is a recipient of the Semiconductor Industry Association and Semiconductor Research Corporation 2024 University Research Awards.



<u>Facundo Fernández</u>, Vasser Woolley Foundation Chair in Bioanalytical Chemistry and Regents' Professor in the School of Chemistry and Biochemistry, has been selected as this year's Anachem Award recipient by the Association of Analytical Chemists.



<u>David Flaherty</u>, professor in the School of Chemical and Biomolecular Engineering, won the 2026 Paul H. Emmett Award in Fundamental Catalysis. The award includes \$5,000 and is presented to two winners every two years.



School of Mathematics Associate Professor <u>Molei Tao</u> has been honored with a Sony Faculty Innovation Award for his work on the foundations of machine learning, particularly diffusion generative models. The award includes a \$100,000 grant.
